FEEDBACK ON THE CONSULTATIVE WORKSHOPS CONDUCTED ON THE ASSESSMENT OF THE NEW NATIONAL CERTIFICATE CURRICULA (TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL)

Following the rolling out of nine (9) curricula for Technical and Vocational Institutes by NCDC in 2016, UBTEB conducted consultative workshops with the training Institutions on the assessment of trainees using the new curricula.

From the consultative workshops, a number of proposals were made, most of which were implemented during the November/December 2016 Examinations. In consultation with NCDC, the Board came up with the following guidelines on assessment:

1. All Programmes/Courses under the new curricula shall have practical Examinations as indicated in the attached guidelines.
2. For Programmes/Courses that have Computer Aided Drawing in the Curriculum, it will be assessed as a Practical Paper as per the guidelines.
3. The content for module TCPL 204: Computer Aided Plumbing Drawing was originally omitted from the curriculum but with consultation with NCDC, the content has been availed for assessment in November/December 2017 as per the assessment guidelines attached.
4. All modules in the curricula except Real Life Project and Industrial Training shall have coursework.
5. The paper codes in these guidelines shall be the ones to appear on the candidates' Academic Transcripts.
